CHARACTERS

MARK 30s - 40s handsome, working class, the kind of guy you want to hang out with, easy to like, funny, not too loud

SETTING

Outside a closed coffee shop during a pandemic.

SCENE

(Mark is standing outside of BRew-Stirs Coffee Shop. There's a big stuffed chicken in the window, and a "closed until further notice" sign on the door. He has just made a phone call. The other dialog is indented and in parentheses for the sake of timing and actor's context, but the audience only hears Mark.)

MARK

Hey, Jackie. It's me.

(Are you still coming?)

Yeah, I just hit a bit of a snag...

(The hot chocolate?)

Yeah, but Brew-Stirs is closed until further notice.

(I can tell her.)

No, no. I'll... figure something out. Can you put her on? Thanks.

(Honey, it's daddy.)

Hi, sweetie!

(Daddy!!)

How are you doing?

(Great. We're celebrating my birthday tomorrow!)

That's sounds like fun, but your birthday's in November.

(Not my three and a half birthday.)

Right. Silly me. Well, I'll have to get you a special three and a half years birthday present.

(Where are you?)

Remember I said I'd get you some hot cocoa from Broo-Stirs?

(The one with the chicken!)

Right. The one with the chicken in the window. Suppose... what if I got it from somewhere else this time?
